As an example of their capability, Dome Chartering & Trading Corp. won a contract with Shell Oil to ship four large Natural Gas tanks from Morehead City, North Carolina to Montego Bay, Jamaica. Shell West Indies was the receiver of the tanks, which were to be used as storage tanks for their operations in Montego Bay.

Dome booked the ocean transport of the tanks with Schuyler Line, which took the MV Kamilla on charter. The vessel was chosen for her box hold, her heavy gear and her ability to load all four tanks below decks. Two tanks were loaded and secured on the tank top, and the other two were loaded and secured on the vessel's movable pontoon decks.

Schuyler Line incorporated their experience in heavy-lift work to ensure that both load and discharge operations went smoothly. Port Captains were assigned in both ports to ensure safety and efficiency, and the tanks were delivered to Jamaica on time and undamaged, and most importantly, in a cost-effective manner.
