Full-time. This position is located in Singapore and will report to the Fleet Technical Manager.


Responsibilities:

- Set clear goals and expectations, coach/mentor Chief Engineers.
- Participate in interviews and makes recommendations regarding new-hires and promotions.
- Monitor vessel performance and ensure follow up action.
- Management of vessel budgets and operating expenditure
- Plan for, monitor, and manage dry-dockings and major scheduled and unscheduled repairs.
- Conduct regular vessel visits to confirm condition and compliance with Company operating standards and provide Vessel Condition Reports.
- Create a partnership with the other departments (HSQE, crewing, operations, etc.) assigned to the same vessels.
- Assist and participate in Incident investigations.
- Travel in support of ship operations; convene safety meetings during vessel visits, address any current issues important to Technical and Vessel Management.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- 5 years sea going experience as a Marine Engineer
- Previous experience as Chief Engineer is preferred but must have at least sea going experience as Second (First USA) Engineer.
- Familiarity and experience with fleet management software, experience with ABS Nautical Systems Enterprise (NSE) would be an advantage.
